.Volunteering opportunities at Poppleton Community Railway Nursery

If you would like to donate a few hours of your time to the nursery there are several ways to help. Skills are not important, everyone is welcome and on the job training is given if needed. Much of the work is on-going and includes the general maintenance and development of the nursery site and business. There are also one-off tasks such as clearing parts of the site, painting, path and building maintenance and planting up cleared areas, as well as helping out with sales on site and at various venues around York.

We are a very enthusiastic group of people and always looking for extra hands to assist in the running of the nursery but also welcome new ideas and initiatives, so as a volunteer you would have the opportunity to suggest new ideas and ways that we could improve our products and service.

Here are the ways you can help:-

General Volunteer (DIY)

The role of the general volunteer is to carry out repairs on buildings, fencing, cold frames and nursery beds, painting the inside and outside of buildings and the maintenance of glasshouses.

Horticultural Volunteer

To help to maintain and develop the formal garden and decorative planting at the nursery: To assist in all aspects of producing plants for sale at the nursery: Propagation, sowing seeds, pricking out, potting on, pruning and plant division. You will also be able to help with the production of hanging baskets and planters to sell on open days and at sales, as well as creating and producing seasonal decorations at Christmas. Training will be given to develop these skills if needed.

Nursery Sales Volunteer

To help with the organisation and running of sales at the nursery and other venues in the York area: Weekly sales and Open Days happen throughout the year at the nursery (Station Road, Poppleton York. YO26 6QA. Sales also take place at York Hospital and other local venues (Visit the Poppleton Community Railway Nursery website for detail of dates and times - <http://www.poppletonrailwaynursery.co.uk/sales.html>).

Narrow Gauge Railway Volunteer

To work under the direction of the narrow gauge railway manager as part of the maintenance team for the narrow gauge railway to lay new track and maintain existing track, to maintain, repair and renovate trucks and rolling stock, as well carrying out some building and maintenance work on the nursery site.
